13. How many different types of sharks are there? Over 300, around 27, or over 1000? (Over 300.)
14. Scabs turn brown in the shower because dirt washes into them, old red blood cells wash off, or soap reacts with the scab and makes it brown. (The old red blood cells wash off—true story.)
15. True or False: There really are such things as Wobbegong sharks. (True)
16. True or False: Scabs are delicious. (Free answer)
