



## INTERNET AND SUBMISSION PERMISSION FORM

Tanglewood Publishing was founded by Peggy Tierney in 2003 to create books that kids will have fun reading. She has asked young readers for their opinions on Tanglewood titles since the beginning. The young readers are a part of the Tanglewood Young Reviewers Initiative. These young reader give feedback to Tanglewood Publishing on middle grade and young adult manuscripts from genres that they have stated an interest in. If a young reader is under 13 years old, s/he must have parental permission to register and participate for the Young Reviewers Initiative. The form below, to be signed by a parent, provides such permission and should be sent to Tanglewood Publishing at Tanglewood Publishing 322 W. 52<sup>nd</sup> Street, #2240, New York, NY 10101.

Tanglewood Publishing requires the young reader's first name, active personal email address, grade in school, and state of residence. This information must be accurate. It is used for verification and to contact the young reader if Tanglewood Publishing has a question about their review. Tanglewood Publishing does NOT share information about a young reader's email address.

Tanglewood Publishing strives to create fun, authentic, interesting books for kids and teens. We ask young readers for their honest feedback to ensure that we're on the right track with what they would want to see published and on bookstore shelves. We ask young readers and/or parents to notify Tanglewood Publishing in a timely manner if the content their children are reading for review raises concerns.

If a young reader is under 13 years old and is submitting a review to Tanglewood Publishing, this parental permission form also grants Tanglewood Publishing permission to publish work in partner media, including their Web sites, or in Tanglewood Publishing publications, including Into the Woods, the Tanglewood Publishing Blog, under his/her name with his/her state and grade in school.

Educators or program coordinators submitting on behalf of youths under 13 years old should have students' parents fill out the form below and send it to Tanglewood Publishing OR make sure the school's/nonprofit's blanket signed parental permission form covers such publication details. The teacher should contact Tanglewood Publishing's Ayanna Coleman to confirm that at the beginning of the school year.

I give permission for my underage child to participate within the Young Reviewers Initiative AND to allow my child's work to be reviewed by Tanglewood Publishing for potential publication in Tanglewood Publishing's publications or with Tanglewood Publishing's media partners. I also understand that it is my responsibility as a parent to monitor my child's activities to ensure he/she is behaving in a respectful manner and is also using common sense to ensure his or her safety. I also understand that it is my and my child's responsibility to notify Tanglewood Publishing if the content of the manuscript makes them feel uncomfortable and they would not like to review it.
