  - The manuscripts you read are confidential, so please do not share what you read with your friends. Instead, if they are interested, have them sign up to be one of our Young Reviewers, and then you can read the manuscripts together.
- Once you're done reading, go back to the e-mail that contained the manuscript and click on the link to the Young Reader's Form.
  - Complete the form to the best of your ability answering a few general questions and some specific questions pertaining to the manuscript at hand. There will always be space to write more to explain your thoughts.
